Need more trusted volunteers! Julie at UoC will be key to this and has students based in Lancaster

Need them to arrive at least 15min early so they are "present" and able to welcome participants who may be anxious and there is a settled, unchaotic first impression at start of workshops.

They made need time to be briefed by facilitators about anyone to look out for – so need to arrive 30mins early to very first session (especially as participants could be very anxious!)

Try to recruit at the Business Breakfast on 7th October and similar opportunities

Volunteers to pop into Thursday workshops prior to DBS etc to get an impression
